We are sure you will have an enjoyable stay with us. Please take a moment to read the following information. We will keep this form on file for reference, so that you will not be inconvenienced upon dropping your pet(s) off for boarding in the future.

1) Pets are **required** to have **current vaccinations**.

For dogs, this includes Rabies, Distemper/Parvo/Corona Virus. Intestinal Parasite Exam(Stool Sample), all given within the last year.

Bordetella is required every 6 months.

For Cats, this includes Rabies and Distemper vaccinations.

2) An additional Charge of **\$4.00** per day is added to the regular fee for boarding, three days prior to, including and three days after a **holiday**.

3) There will be an additional **\$3.00** per day, per dog for administration of medication while your pet is staying with us.

4) We cannot guarantee the return of personal items, such as blankets or toys, we do have our own blankets here that we provide for each animal. For the safety no rawhides, pig ears, or any chew toy will be permitted. If your animal does need a chew toy we will provide safe rawhides and/or toys. These items are furnished free of charge by Wheaton Animal Hospital to all boarders during their stay.

5) In the event of a medical emergency, treatment will be given and a reasonable effort will be made to contact you at the emergency number you have provided. Daily monitoring of pets by staff is included in routine care.

6) I realize that despite the hospital's best efforts, intestinal upsets(vomiting/diarrhea) are common in boarded animals due to the change of environment. If your pet experiences any of these symptoms after their stay with us, please notify us immediately as most of the time these conditions are not serious and easily treated.

7) Due to the fact we cannot control the flea/tick population outdoors we highly recommend a frontline treatment be applied before boarding.

8) Boarding can be stressful and even if your pets are best friends at home, sometimes being kenneled together they can aggravate each other. If you would like we can board your pets separately. Please inform us at drop off of your decision.
